Coleman Avenue/Autumn Street Improvements

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to an informational meeting regarding the above-referenced project. The City of San Jose is in the process of preparing an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for this project. Soon you will receive a notice of preparation (NOP) for this EIR. The purpose of this meeting is for City staff to describe the project, the EIR process, and provide you the opportunity to learn more about the project and ask questions.

Background: The City of San Jose's General Plan and Downtown Strategy 2000 Plan identify the Coleman Avenue and Autumn Street projects as future transportation improvements for the Downtown Plan.

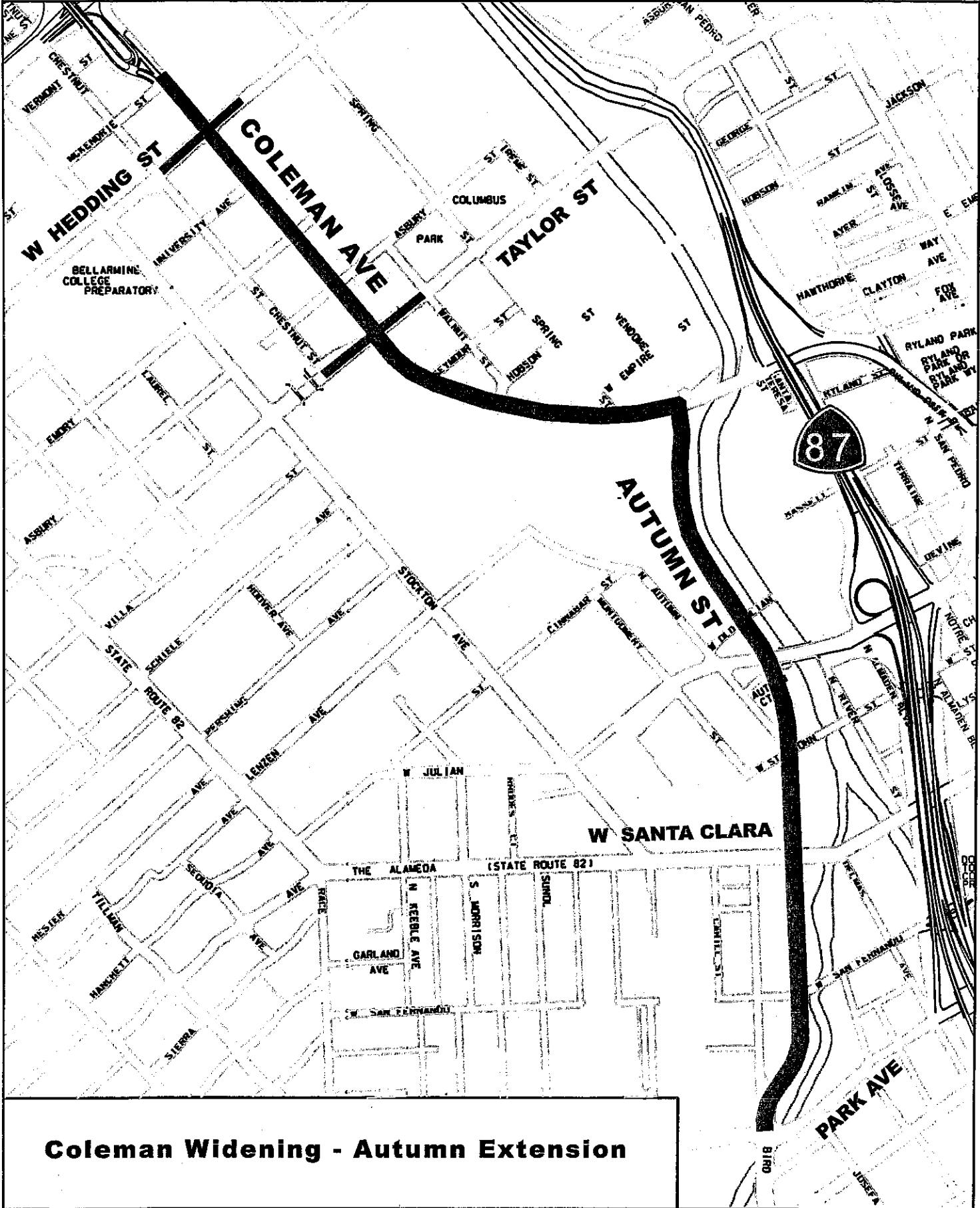
Project description: This project proposes to widen Coleman Avenue to a 6-lane arterial street, to widen Autumn Street to 4-lane arterial street from Park Avenue to Santa Clara Street, and to extend Autumn Street from St John to Coleman Avenue along the west bank of the Guadalupe River.

At this time, the City is seeking to obtain environmental clearance for this project. No additional funding has been identified; therefore, the no construction schedule is available. At the time of implementation, this project will require acquisition of private properties and possible removal of existing buildings along the Guadalupe River west bank and the following streets: Coleman Avenue, Autumn Street, Hedding Street, Taylor Street, Old Autumn Street, and Autumn Court.

Parking will be available at the Fourth Street Garage or the City Hall Garage (on Sixth Street).
